# Important Announcement – Tuesday 07/07/2020 Jumu'ah Salah/Opening Times from 10/07/2020

Alhamdulillah, we have recently reopened the doors to the Masjid for the 5 daily congregational prayers and it has been great to see our community back in the Masjid again. We would like to thank everyone for their patience and cooperation during this difficult time. We humbly request everyone to continue to bear with us to ensure we can provide a safe environment for everyone to perform their prayers.

We are now able to confirm with you our timings for Jumu'ah Salah

 $1^{\text{st}}$  Jumu'ah Salah will take place at 1:30pm. The masjid will open at 1:00pm  $2^{\text{nd}}$  Jumu'ah Salah will take place at 3:00pm. The masjid will open at 2:45pm  $3^{\text{rd}}$  Jumu'ah Salah will take place at 5:00pm. The masjid will open at 4:45pm

We strongly advise all musallees that are at home to consider coming for the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Jumu'ah to allow those musallees coming from work to attend the 1<sup>st</sup> Jumu'ah.

Please note that the Masjid capacity is currently 220 and once reached, the doors have to close.

Anyone that has mobility issues that require the use of a chair will have a space allocated for

them downstairs in the hall. The lift will be out of use.

### Please **DO NOT ATTEND** if the following applies:

- If you are under 12
- If you are ill or have a fever (high temperature above 37.5 Celsius) or underlying health conditions
- Over 70's are still advised to pray at home

Please perform Wudhu before attending

Please bring the following items with you:

- Prayer Mat
- Mask
- <u>Reusable</u> carrier bag for your shoes. Please help us minimise waste and think of the environment

#### MEASURES IN PLACE FOR JUMU'AH PRAYERS

- Please follow the instructions from the volunteers at all times
- Car park will be open. Gates will be closed once all bays have been occupied. No parking in central pathway in the car park or on health centre car park next door. Local residents are requested to walk to the Masjid.
- It is recommended to wear face masks whilst visiting the Masjid
- Please maintain a 1 metre plus distance within the car park and in the Masjid at all times
- You will be required to clean your hands using the hand sanitizers at the entrance/exit
- Toilets, Wudhu Khana and other non-essential areas will be closed
- Shoes and coats to be taken with you and placed next to your prayer mat
- You will be required to perform your prayers, recitation and zikr on the designated space
- Heating will remain switched off. All windows will stay open to enable good ventilation
- Congregating in groups in the Masjid and car park must be avoided.

All measures are subject to change. Announcements will be made after any Salah or communicated via our social media accounts following any release of guidance from the Government.

We would like to thank everyone for their cooperation and patience.
