Important Announcement – Wednesday 04/11/20 Closure of the Masjid for Congregational Prayers from 05/11/20

Dear Respected Community,

The Committee of Masjid-e-Sajedeen, would like to sincerely thank everyone in our community for their sacrifice and co-operation over the last few months since we reopened for congregational prayers. Alhamdulillah, our Masjid has been running smoothly with all musallees following social distancing guidelines and adhering to the instructions of the volunteers. May He reward everyone for their sacrifices and co-operation. Ameen

Following the announcement from the Government in relation to the 2nd lockdown, it is with great sadness that we have to announce that our Masjid will close for daily congregational prayers (including Jum'uah prayers) from Fajr Salah on Thursday 05/11/20. We will remain open **for individual solitary prayer only** in line with Government guidelines on a daily basis **from 6:30pm to 7:30pm.**

We humbly request that all attendees to the Masjid comply with the Government guidelines and respect the advice and guidance of the Masjid and the local volunteer enforcement team on the premises who are there for the safety of everyone.

For the safety of everyone, please **DO NOT ATTEND** if the following applies:

- If you are under 12
- If you have symptoms, ill or have a fever (high temperature of 38 Celsius or above) or underlying health conditions
- Over 60's are advised to pray at home

Things to remember

Please perform Wudhu before attending

Please bring the following items with you:

- Prayer Mat
- Mask
- Quran/Tasbeeh

For the safety of everyone, these following measures will be in place within the premises of the Masjid:

- Please maintain a 2 metre distance within the car park and in the Masjid at all times
- A mask must be worn at all times
- You will be required to clean your hands using the hand sanitizers at the entrance

- Please avoid touching non-essential surfaces like radiators, railings (unless required), cupboards, doors and coat hangers etc.
- Toilets, Wudhu Khana and other non-essential areas will be closed
- You will be required to perform your prayers, recitation and zikr on the designated space
- All windows will stay open to enable ventilation
- Only the main Jamaat Khana will be in use
- You will be required to clean your hands using the hand sanitizers at the exit
- Congregating in the car park must be avoided.

The Government has announced that this lockdown will last till Wednesday 2nd December 2020. Any changes to the rule regarding congregational prayer or any other measures will be made in accordance to Government guidelines.

We may make announcements after Esha prayers on the receiver system if there are any updates.
